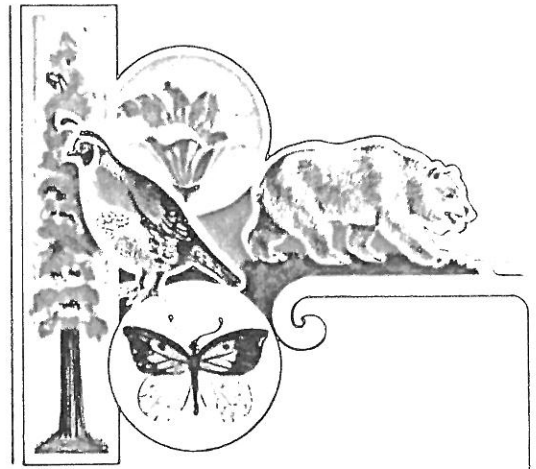

I

The name of this corporation shall be IRVINE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.

II

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California. This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized for nonprofit purposes.

III

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

(a) To extend and promote trade and commerce in and about Irvine, Orange County, California; to encourage and assist in public improvements of all kinds; to locate schools and libraries, and disseminate information and do all things which look toward higher and better educational advantages; to conduct merchants' associations and otherwise assist and promote the bringing of merchants, manufacturers and parties engaged in trade into closer association and work for mutual advantages and protection; to conduct a Board of Trade with all of the necessary adjuncts; to organize and conduct any other bureau or bureaus or exchanges, as this corporation shall decide are for the best interests of it and of the community; to foster and promote in every lawful manner the commercial, educational and moral development of Irvine and its environs, and do any and all things which are for the public good.

(b) To buy, sell, acquire, hold, manage, improve, encumber by mortgage and trust deed or otherwise, lease, rent and exchange and in all ways own, hold manage, dispose of, control, deal in and deal with all and every kind of real property, buildings, structures, easements and rights in realty useful, beneficial or convenient for the use of the corporation.

(c) To buy, sell acquire, hold manage, improve, encumber by mortgage and trust deed or otherwise, hypothecate, pledge, lease, exchange, construct and in all ways own, hold manage; dispose of, deal in and deal with all and every kind of personal property necessary, useful, beneficial or convenient for the use of the corporation.

(d) To carry on any other lawful business whatsoever which may seem to the corporation capable of being carried on, or calculated directly or indirectly to promote the purposes of the corporation; and to have, use, hold, enjoy and exercise all the rights, powers and privileges which are now or which may hereafter be conferred upon corporations organized under the same statutes.

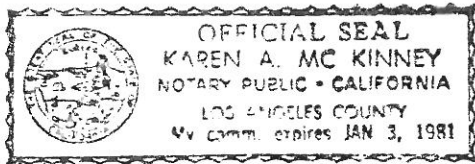
